Need for the Workshop

Play and cognitive development are inter-related. This is well explained in Piaget's theory of cognitive development. Play is an essential activity of early childhood as it contributes to the cognitive, social and emotional development of children. Children with developmental delays may not develop natural play skills as Neuro typical children. This often leads to a scatter in areas of development. In addition, a child may be developmentally stuck at a particular stage not knowing how to progress to the next and this can lead to fixations, repetitive behaviors and meaningless patterns. Stimulating the development of Play skills sets the stage for all subsequent development.
